### **ABOUT ISTD**

The Indian Society for Training & Development (ISTD) is a premier National institution devoted to the cause of **Human Resource Development and Training**, with international affiliations, to International Federation of Training and Development Organizations (**IFTDO**), Geneva and Asian Regional Training and Development Organization (**ARTDO**), Manila. It was registered in April 1970, as a non-profit Society, under the Societies Registration Act, 1860. It has a large membership of institutions and professionals, involved in the **training and development of human resources** from **government, public and private sector organizations, institutions and other bodies**. ISTD has **45 chapters** located throughout the country with the **National Headquarters** at **New Delhi**.

The Society publishes a **Quarterly Journal “Indian Journal of Training and Development” (IJTD)**, for which it has an international Editorial Advisory Board.

ISTD conducts a **Diploma Course** in Training & Development, through correspondence spanning over 18 months’ duration (one year for academic - Work followed by internship field assignment of six months). The **flagship course** is recognized by the **Ministry of Human Resource Development**, Government of India, for the purposes of recruitment to superior positions under the Central Government. It is also approved by the **Department of Personnel and Training (DoPT)**, Govt. of India under its Faculty Development Scheme and by many of the corporates for appointments/ promotions and incentives in their organizations.

ISTD hosted **4th IFTDO** International Conference in 1975 and **23rd IFTDO World Conference** during 1994 in New Delhi. Both these Conferences were inaugurated by the then **Hon’ble Presidents of India**. Recently, the Society also hosted, **33rd IFTDO World Conference & Exhibition** in New Delhi during 22-25 November, 2004, which was also inaugurated by the **Hon’ble President of India**, Dr A P J Abdul Kalam.

ISTD has signed a **Memorandum of Understanding** with **Baharin Society** for Training & Development, for mutual co-operation and furtherance of common objectives in the field of ‘Training & Development’.
